Dr. Saul Hertz Of Boston Honored

ATLANTIC CITY, May 6 — Dr. Saul Hertz of Boston, thyroid researchist, today was elected a member of the Society of Clinical Investigation at its annual meeting. The society, known as "the Young Turks" because all members resign at the age of 40, is chiefly interested in applying other sciences to medicine. Dr. Hertz was graduated from Harvard medical school in 1929, is

research associate at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and Harvard, and is assistant in medicine at the Massachusetts General Hospital, in charge of the thyroid clinic.
